Welcome to our 4th annual offering of Glasoe Angus females, where you can purchase cattle stacked with generations of pedigree and proven performance at commercial values.

Our registered replacement dams for sale exhibit proven fertility, fleshing ability, udder integrity and structural longevity. Several sale dams have produced calves that weigh more than 800 pounds at 205 days and have achieved Pathfinder status as outstanding cows in our herd. We reserve the right to a flush on these dams if enacted by the buyer. Our replacement dams are bred to sires (shown below) that also earned 800-plus pounds at 205 days.

We will also offer the fresh genetics of multiple registered and commercial bred heifers and commercial open heifers with Glasoe Angus pedigrees in their maternal and paternal lineage. Our inaugural cosigners, Lance and Kelly Skor, and Lee and Erin Vassen will be selling approximately 40 open heifers. Our bred heifer consigner, Ryan Ross, purchased 20 open heifers from Dennis Jacobson this spring. They are bred to G A Genesis 931, who weighed 65 pounds at birth and 1,197 pounds on his birthday. He scores double-digit calving ease at a +13 CED.

These Glasoe Angus dams represent our S A V Resource daughters. Easy-fleshing, wide-topped, docile and broody, these dams profile how well Resource has blended with our maternal genetics.







Our open heifer calves exhibit the performance and phenotype that blossom from our maternal genetics and mothering ability.

Glasoe Angus females rely solely on their dam's milk, pasture grass and CRP hay for their wean and yearling weights, as well as their body condition scores as mature cows. Leftover corn silage is provided in our hay mix for two weeks after we turn cow/calf pairs out in April. Data on each registered female, as well as progeny wean ratio, will be available sale day.
